Issue #1: Presidents Report – Soccerfest & District Cup – Applications received from VP, Select, MT, LC, PG (some), EGCPL. Managers need to make sure coaches are in good standing. Some were received in mail. Has not received any from WL, EG, RM. District Cup is due tonight. Soccerfest by next Monday. League pays for referees for Soccerfest and District Cup for Recreational and Select. School facilities are being confirmed at this time. Any club wishing to use a school facility needs to talk to Gayle.

Issue #2: September minutes. Unanimously approved.

Issue #3: Pictures are done and invoice received. Trophies have been ordered.

Issue #4: Treasurer Report: \$38,000 for pics. Up to date on bills. Still need to pay for trophies and referees for the rest of the year.

Issue #5: New website is up and running. Hotline is fairly quiet, with just a few minor complaints that were easily addressed.

Issue #6: Referee report – There have been some problems with parents behavior on the sideline. Managers need to help coaches deal with this. Weekly meetings are going well. Lots of good information is being exchanged. Some parents are following referees over to where there gear is such as at halftime and after games. This is not to be tolerated.

Issue #7: Registrar Report: Kathy Ayala reelected as District 6 manager. Division 1 U-9,10 will be offered in District 6 next year. Total player count to this point 5,795.

Issue #8: Field Manager: Moveable goals have to be either staked in place or locked together. If you stake them, adult teams may move in on them on the weekends and cause field overuse. Recommend that they be locked up for safety. Need to turn down water at Strong. Schools are still overwatering. Games at Eddy have all been moved to Franklin West for the rest of the year. Orange barriers are down at Nottoli, but stay off

until November 1. Practices (under the lights) for Competitive will start Oct 30 at LCP, and Select will go to Nottoli. U-10 Select and Comp teams will be using the Nottoli baseball field lights together. Need to work this out.

Issue #9: Competitive Program Report: Info night is Oct 20<sup>th</sup> at Albiani.

Issue #10: Select Program Report: Lots of teams going to District Cup. Several teams were moved up at the midway point. U-9,10 – CYSA allows 9v9. District mandates 8v8. District rules will be followed.

Issue # 11: US Club may offer play for all 3 classes in the spring. This is just rumor. They do not classify teams as Division 1, 3 or 4. It is one classification, and it is seen as equivalent to Class 1 by CYSA.

Good of the Game: Mark Lloret's team the Valkyries U-16 girls took 4<sup>th</sup> at the Roseville Tournament.
